Meet and where possible exceed the requirements of our clients and stakeholders in relation to OH&S;



Encourage the full participation of all employees in meeting OH&S objectives and targets;

Encourage employees to take ownership of OH&S issues through regular joint consultation;

Maintain good communications with all interested parties, which will aid the development of the OH&S management system and any 'workplace', 'Service' and or 'System' improvements that are required to be made;
